-Musicians Masks are approved by LA County of Dept of Health BUT NOT by LAUSD...yet!

- Our next steps, are to ask the district to send out a bulletin allowing us to follow LA county
 guidelines and return inside if we so desire, we are seeking professional flexibility.
- If we can get approval to return to inside instruction, we then plan to tackle the concerts conversation.

-PPE has begun being distributed. Fill out this survey so we can track which schools need follow up.

Background Info Reminder: We sought to pursue this for the teachers who have admin that do not know or care to support the arts, every music program should have PPE regardless of admin discretion.

- ii. UTLA takes position of LAUSD being the safest in the country so hesitant to allow wind instruments indoors

- iv. Nobody received the musicians mask (vocal) because county didn't approve of it before
